

Below are some examples of wording that can be used in a will for the purposes of a bequest to the Baptist Churches of South Australia and the Northern Territory Inc.

These paragraphs can also be used if you wish to add a bequest to one of our churches. Just replace the name, address and position (see *italicised* items below) with that of the church you wish to support.

It is recommended that you seek professional advice when preparing a will.

A specific sum

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) the sum of \$..... to the *Baptist Churches of South Australia and the Northern Territory Inc of 35 King William Road Unley SA 5061*, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the *Director of Ministries* or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

A percentage

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) % to the *Baptist Churches of South Australia and the Northern Territory Inc of 35 King William Road Unley SA 5061*, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the *Director of Ministries* or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

The residue

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) the residue of my estate to the *Baptist Churches of South Australia and the Northern Territory Inc of 35 King William Road Unley SA 5061*, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the *Director of Ministries* or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

Specific purpose bequeath

If the bequeath is to be used for a specific purpose, then the line “*for the specific purpose of (describe what you want the gift to be used for), but if such purpose cannot in the opinion of the Board be achieved, then*” can be inserted between the address and the words “to be used in such a manner as its Board determines.”
