SURVIVOR SUPPORT ADVISORY PROGRAM

The Survivor Support Advisory Program is designed to provide advice to any person who has experienced historic child sexual abuse and never disclosed and or reported the abuse to police but are now considering doing so.

The abuse could have occurred in any setting within or outside of any church / denomination or organisation, and the survivor now attends a Baptist Church. This is a ministry arm of BCSA & NT.

The program is not an investigative or counselling program, but one which provides advice in relation to what the process and landscape would like, assisting individuals to make fully informed decisions.

Those who access the SSA Program are encouraged to make final decisions in conjunction with their pastor, counsellor and families.
